The Rules of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews will apply.

LOCAL RULES

- 1. OUT OF BOUNDS.** A ball is out of bounds when it is lying beyond the perimeter fence/hedges to the left of the 13th hole, (b) 16th and 17th hole within the gardens of Queenwood Lodge (c) to the right of the 1st hole, (d) right of the 4th hole, (e) to the right hand side of the 2nd & 6th holes in or over the ditch, as marked by white stakes.
- 2. WATER HAZARDS** are indicated by Yellow Stakes.
- 3. LATERAL WATER HAZARDS** are indicated by Red Stakes.
- 4. PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES IDENTIFIED BY STAKE OR WIRE WRAP.** If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or area of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b (i). The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.
- 5. FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS.** All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if such an obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief, without penalty as follows:- If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club-lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids such intervention and (c) is not a hazard or on a putting green.
- 6. STONES** in bunkers are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1 applies)
- 7. GROUND UNDER REPAIR: PLAY PROHIBITED.** If a player's ball lies in an area of "ground under repair" from which play is prohibited, or if such an area of "ground under repair" interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing the player must take relief under Rule 25-1.
- 8. DEER PRINTS.** A ball found in a deer print in a bunker may be lifted and dropped without penalty. In accordance with Rule 25-1.
- 9. GPS, DMD (Distance Measuring Devices)** are permitted.

Penalty for breach of a Local Rule:

Match Play – loss of hole

Stroke Play – two strokes
