



Fishing on Calstone Lake

Calstone Lake is stocked with Rainbow Trout. It is planned to re-stock the Lake as necessary during the season. No further re-stocking takes place after mid-September.

- **Rods:**

- The syndicate is limited. Fishing can take place on any day throughout the season between dawn and dusk, subject to weekly bag limits.
- A guest may be brought by a member on four days during the season, having given prior notice to the Syndicate Manager, who has the right to refuse for a guest to fish at his discretion. (If a guest fished then the combined weekly limit is still only 4 fish.) Members must accompany their guests at all times.
- Rods are non-transferable and guest may not fish unless accompanied by a member.

- **Code of Conduct:**

- The season commences on 12th April each year. The date of closing will be posted in the members hut towards the end of the season.
- Dry fly, wet fly or nymph may be used on the lake with one fly on the cast and no hook size to be over 10, except for Damsel-fly or Mayfly Nymph, when size 10 long shank hooks may be used. No lures are permitted.
- The weekly bag limit is to be 2 brace. All Browns to be carefully returned. No catch and return of Rainbows after 15th September. The first two Rainbows must be taken on each visit to the lake.
- Wading is not allowed.
- Dogs should be kept under control and not allowed to disturb other members.
- Please keep the gate closed at all times.
- All fish caught to be entered in the returns book in the hut by the lake. Members are particularly asked to adhere to this rule, as it is important for estimating re-stocking.

- **Overall Information:**

- National Rivers Authority Licences are required.
- The Bowood Estate will accept no responsibility for any accident or loss sustained by any member while on the fishery.
- Members are requested to keep to approved pathways and to take care not to damage farmland or crops.
