The Rules of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews will apply.

LOCAL RULES

- 1. OUT OF BOUNDS. A ball is out of bounds when 5. FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS. All fixed sprinkler it is lying beyond the perimeter fence/hedges (a) to the left of the 4th hole. (b) to the left of the 7th and 8th holes, within the gardens of Queenwood Lodge, (c) to the right of the 10th and 13th holes and (d) to the right of the 11th and 15th holes in or over the ditch, as marked by the white stakes.
- 2. ALTERNATIVE TO STROKE AND DISTANCE FOR LOST BALL OR BALL OUT OF BOUNDS. If a player's ball has not been found or is known or virtually certain to be out of bounds, the player may take relief for two penalty strokes by dropping the original or another ball (see rule 14.3) using the Ball Reference Point or Fairway Reference Point, rather than proceeding under stroke and distance.
- Exception This local rule does NOT apply in handicap qualifying competitions or where the committee have declared the local rule excluded within the terms of the competition.
- 3. NO PLAY ZONES. Any area encircled by white paint, wire wrap, or electrical fencing are No Play Zones and are to be treated as Abnormal Ground Conditions Free relief must be taken from the interference by the No Play Zones under rule 16.1
- 4. PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES IDENTIFIED BY STAKE OR WIRE WRAP. Any young trees identified by stake or wire wrap are No Play Zones:
- If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a *Penalty Area* and it lies on or touches such a tree or such tree interferes with the players stance or area of intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule
- If the ball lies in a Penalty Area, and interference to the player's stance or area of intended swing exists from such a tree, the player **must** take relief either with a penalty under Rule 17.1e or with free relief under Rule 17.1e (2)

- heads are Immovable Obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 16.1. The player also has these extra options to take relief when a fixed sprinkler head is close to the Putting Green within the and on the *line of play*: Ball in *General* Area. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if a Fixed Sprinkler Head is:
- Within 2 club-lengths of the Putting Green and within the General Area, and
- Within 2 club-lengths of the ball

Exception - There is no relief under this rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.

- 6. ANIMAL HOOF DAMAGE. Damage that is clearly identifiable as having been caused by animal hoofs is Ground Under Repair from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1. Where the Abnormal Ground Condition exists in a Bunker relief may be taken under Rule 16.1c. Under which, for free relief to apply, the nearest point of complete relief must be within the Bunker.
- 7. PROHIBITING PLAY FROM THE FRINGE OF THE WRONG GREEN. Through the course of play, if the player must take relief under Rule 13.1f. The relief area to be used when taking this relief, the Putting Green is defined to include the area of fairway within two club lengths from the edge of the Putting Green.

Penalty for breach of a Local Rule: Match Play - Loss of Hole Stroke Play - General Penalty (2 Strokes)
